I was appalled to hear that you suggest to reduce the leverage in retail forex customer accounts to 10:1. It is impossible. Think of it that only some weeks ago I worked happily with leverage 400:1. In addition, I urgently entreat you to return the hedging to forex trade. When you removed it about six months ago, you ruined all my trade strategy. It did not recover since, and it will be great help if you return the possibility of hedging.
