

The **City of Edmonton** is responsible for the development of its own **basements**. It does not have any influence on the development of private or commercial **basements**, except in restricted instances where public safety issues are involved.

There are a lot of buildings in **the city of Edmonton**, which is located in Alberta, Canada. The city has more than 100,000 structures and many of these were built as early as 1892.
