As a Forex trader, I would like to urge you to consider not altering the Forex margin rules for Retail Forex. We who are self-guided Forex traders have not, and realistically could not, in any way affect the market in the way that large financial institutions do. Many of us, myself included, manage to make a modest living from Retail Forex trading and depend on the margin requirements as they now stand. All of us know the risks and also the advantages of trading on margin.

Please consider selective re-regulation where appropriate to each area of the market, but don't penalize those of us who had no part in recent market abuses.
